Cacti is an open-source, web-based network monitoring and graphing tool designed as a front-end application for the data logging tool RRDtool. Cacti allows a user to poll services at predetermined intervals and graph the resulting data. Wyatt Zacharias will be giving us a new look at this software.



## RTFM: `systemctl(1)`

Most Linux distros have now adopted `systemd` as the new `init` process. Gilbert Detillieux will introduce the very basics of using `systemctl(1)` to control daemons in a `systemd`-based environment.
